

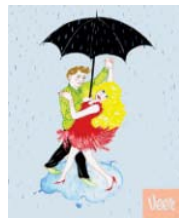

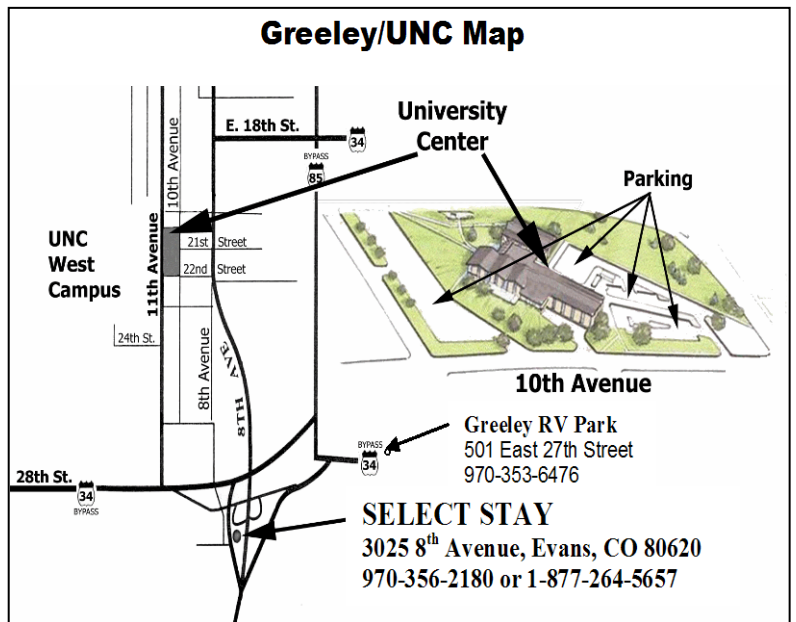

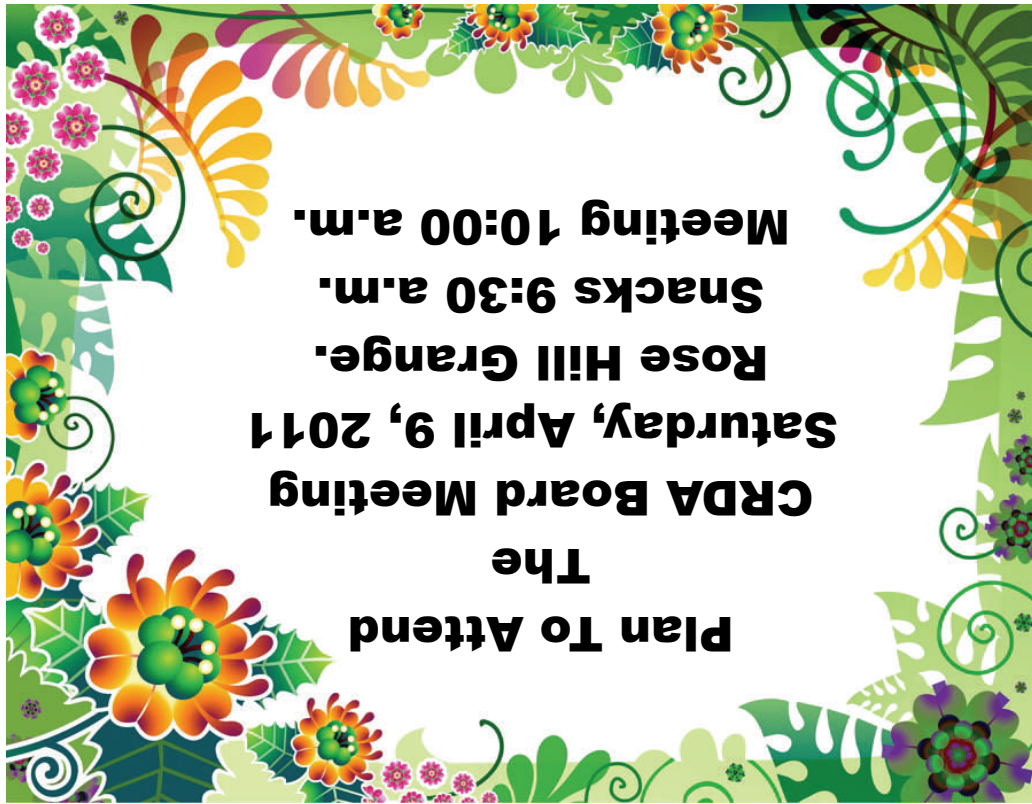

- Ballroom dancing: 265
