## BYLAW CHANGES

We are submitting the following CRDA Bylaw change proposals to be voted on by the membership at the next General Meeting (November 2012). Any CRDA member may submit Bylaw change proposals for consideration. We are not submitting them as CRDA President, nor are they being submitted from the Board of Directors. ### CRDA Bylaw Change Proposal #1

Purpose: Add definitions to the Bylaws, by including a new Article.

Justification: Definitions that are integral to the meaning of the Bylaws are currently not included in the Bylaws themselves. Because they are not part of the Bylaws, they are not protected from modification by requiring a 2/3 vote at the General CRDA meeting.

I am particularly concerned about the definition of Cuer/Instructor, because Article IV. Management, Section 3. Election of the Board of Directors reads:

“B ... The Board of Directors shall consist of no more than (3) instructors or instructors couples.”

With 9 members of the CRDA Board of Directors, there are 8 voting members (the voting ability of the President is limited). Therefore, in order for the “dancers” to retain the majority of the vote, instructors/cuers can only have a maximum of 3 voting positions.

There have been efforts to modify the cuer/instructor definition, without a Bylaw change. I am proposing including the Definitions in the Bylaws, in order to allow the general membership to study and consider the ramifications of such a change.

#### **Article XII. Definitions**

**The following definitions apply to these Bylaws.**

***Board, Current:*** Those members of the CRDA Board of Directors who are currently serving their terms of office.

***Board, New:*** Those members of the CRDA Board of Directors who will serve in the upcoming year.

***Board, Outgoing:*** Those members of the CRDA Board of Directors whose term of office ends in the current year.

***Cuer, Instructor:*** An individual or couple who provides instruction in Round Dancing and/or cues at Round or Square Dance events.

***Cue:*** The act of verbally announcing the figures and steps of a Round Dance routine as an aid to dancers.

***Gala:*** An annual Round Dance event sponsored by CRDA, traditionally held in November.

***Guest Instructor:*** A cuer/instructor hired to provide instruction at the Gala.

***Member:*** Individual, couple, or family at a single mailing address who participate and/or are interested in Round Dancing and decide to join CRDA.

---

**CRDA Bylaw Change Proposal  
#2**

Purpose: To add a membership requirement to the Bylaws.

Justification: This has been a standing rule and accepted practice within CRDA. This change adds it to the Bylaws.

Article III – Members

**Section 5. Membership Requirement.**

**Only members in good standing are eligible to serve on the CRDA Board of Directors or CRDA committees, to cue or provide instruction at CRDA sponsored events, or to hold a proxy at CRDA meetings.**

**CRDA Bylaw Change Proposal  
#3**

Purpose: To clarify cuer/instructor restriction on Board of Directors.

Justification: Since this was changed to the single term “instructor”, it has caused misinterpretation and confusion of the intent of this restriction. Adding the term “cuer/instructor” helps clarify the intent.

Also see the justification for Bylaw Change Proposal #1 (adding Definitions to the Bylaws).

**Article IV. Management. Section 3 B.**

**Currently reads:**

Directors shall be residents of the State of Colorado. The Board of Directors shall consist of no more than three (3) instructors or instructor couples. Representation on the Board of Directors shall be sought from as wide a geographical area as possible.

**Proposal:**

Directors shall be residents of the State of Colorado. The Board of Directors shall consist of no more than three (3) ~~instructors or instructor couples~~ **cuer/instructor individuals or couples**. Representation on the Board of Directors shall be sought from as wide a geographical area as possible.

---

**CRDA Bylaw Change Proposal  
#4**

Purpose: To allow re-election of Directors with a two 3-year term limit.

Justification: It has become increasingly hard to find eligible CRDA members willing to serve on the Board of Directors. The last 4 vice presidents have had a very difficult time finding candidates. We can anticipate this trend to continue.

Furthermore, with the addition of financial responsibilities beyond keeping a checking account, the Treasurer position requires special accounting skills. Finding a qualified candidate can be a problem.

This Bylaw change will allow the Board will allow someone qualified to stay on the board for 2 terms, if they wish.

This proposal does not require Directors to stay on the Board for two 3-year terms, nor does it automatically allow the Directors to stay on the Board. It only allows them to apply for re-election if they desire.

#### **Article IV. Management. Section 3 A.**

##### **Currently reads:**

All candidates for the Board of Directors shall be members in good standing of CRDA. Annually three (3) Directors shall be elected for a term of three (3) years. Directors shall not serve consecutive terms. At least one year shall elapse between terms.

##### **Proposal:**

All candidates for the Board of Directors shall be members in good standing of CRDA. Annually three (3) Directors shall be elected for a term of three (3) years. ~~Directors shall not serve consecutive terms.~~ **If they desire, Directors will be eligible for re-election and serve two consecutive terms. At least one year shall elapse between terms. After serving two consecutive terms, at least one year shall elapse before Directors are eligible for re-election.**

##### Call to Order:

President, Rose del Sol called the meeting to order at 2:30 pm.

##### Approval of Last Meeting's Minutes:

Approved as read.

##### Treasurer's Report:

Chuck Thompson filed a 1099 with the IRS for the Fisher's and Prekitt's. He filed a 1096 with the IRS which is the cover letter for the 1099's. He paid \$10 to the State of Colorado for the annual non-profit registration. He filed with The Federal Government an e-post card registration which does not cost. The treasury is approximately \$1100 ahead of last year at this time but is mostly because of pre-paid lunches for the 2012 Gala and a profit from 2011 Gala. CRDA made over \$600 at the 2011 Gala. Hearing equipment is done being depreciated. Fun Dances are about breaking even.

##### President's Report:

No report.

### Vice President's Report:

Spring Dance is April 22<sup>nd</sup> at the Avalon Ballroom in Boulder.

### Harvest Moon Dance:

Needs a Chairman.

### Gala:

A report was read by Eileen Krause from Jim and Margie Garcia. Jim and Margie Garcia have read The Operating Procedures (Red Book) and are using it as a guide to explain to the volunteers what they need to do and with whom to coordinate. They plan on getting everything done for the Gala earlier. They will try to implement all the comments and suggestions from the 2011 Gala evaluations. Jim and Margie Garcia have offers from the following people to help: Assistant Chair: Karen and John Herr, Clinicians: Bob and Sally Nolan and Peter and Chama Gomez, Registration: Tracy Smith (would like to co-chair with someone), Program: Rose del Sol aided by Terri Cantrell, Publicity: Judy and Fred Layberger, Syllabus: Karen and John Herr, Sound: Ed Glenn, Photography: Jim and Judy Taylor, Signs: Patrick and Eileen Krause, Hearing Assistance Equipment: Jim Taylor. Eileen Krause read a list of questions from Jim and Margie Garcia about the Gala. The board answered the questions, and Eileen Krause will send the answers to Jim and Margie Garcia. The overall theme was that the Gala Chair has flexibility. Rose del Sol announced that Fred and Judy Layberger are the publicity chair for the Gala and all CRDA events so that publicity is centralized. If you need a flyer for a CRDA event, please ask Judy Layberger to make one for your event. The board discussed about the possibility of changing the host hotel.

### Membership Report:

Jean Montgomery reported that there 119 members. She will do a mailing by the end of January. Any ideas to increase membership, please contact her.

### Round Notes Report:

Karen Herr reported that the deadline for the next Round Notes is January 15<sup>th</sup>. Karen Herr would like a Sunshine and Shadows section added to Round Notes.

### Fun Dances Report:

Roy Knight reported that the July Fun Dance will not be at The Carriage Stop in Colorado Springs due to a price increase. He feels it is essential to have a dance in Colorado Springs. Roy Knight reported that he will not find a hall. Chuck Thompson volunteered to find a hall. A motion was made by Chris Cantrell and seconded by Fred Layberger: For the December 8th Fun Dance, Roy Knight will pay the Rose Hill Grange and John Herr out of his pocket, and all the profit from the dance will be split between the Rose Hill Grange and the Maple Grove Grange. Motion passed. Fred Layberger suggested putting a question in Round Notes asking why dancers come to some dances and not others. Do dancers go to Fun Dances based on location or cuers? Terri Cantrell would like both names of cuer couples listed on flyers. Terri Cantrell reported that Peach Fun Dance has a second cuer, but she didn't have the name.

### Historian Report:

Harold Sears reported for Meredith Sears. She is grateful for the photographers for all the photos. She is trying to expand the Historian Notebook to cover all CRDA events not just the Gala.

### Cuer Selection Committee Report:

Rose del Sol reported that the cuer selection committee consists of: Harold and Cindy Van Hooser, Harold and Meredith Sears, and Patrick and Eileen Krause. The Assistant Gala Chair is on the committee and can give input, but are not voting members.

### Hall of Fame Report:

No report. Kent and Pam Long are the chair. The committee consists of: Kent and Pam Long, and Dennis and Peggy Plum.

Terri Cantrell can only put on current information on the website if she is given new information. Please send her current club information. If somebody would like to take over the webpage, she is willing to train you, but you need to have website experience. Terri Cantrell has been the webmaster since 1989. She reported that she usually takes time off after the Gala, and that she usually starts up dating the website again in late January.

Old Business:

Rose del Sol posed a question: Should another reflector list be made that lists board members and committee chairs so that she can email them the board meeting agenda? Another reflector list is not needed, instead Rose del Sol will send the agenda to all members. Rose del Sol wants an electronic voting protocol, and asked Chris Cantrell to develop the protocol.

The board decided that Jim and Margie Garcia can bring the budget to the April board meeting.

Operating procedures book (Red Book) update.

No discussion.

New Business:

A motion was made by Harold Sears and seconded by Karen Herr: Each CRDA member attendee at a Fun Dance will be placed in a drawing, the drawing will be held at the 2012 Gala for two registrations to the 2013 Gala. Motion passed. This could be a benefit to join CRDA, and increase Fun Dance attendance. Terri Cantrell recommended that the Fun Dance Chair take a more involved roll in the Fun Dances such as taking money at the Fun Dances and keeping track of the names for the drawing.

Rose del Sol read a letter from Earl Smith that UNC's fee for the 2013 gala would be \$4127.50. Rose del Sol would like the board to use their connections to check out other possible halls for 2013, and bring all the information to the next board meeting. UNC has 10,000 square feet, split into thirds.

Eileen Krause suggested that since UNC has increased the hall cost to not have a decorations budget, maybe with the exception of CRDA buying another arch.

A motion was made by Harold Sears and seconded by Melanie Thompson to adjourn at 4:40 pm. Motion passed.

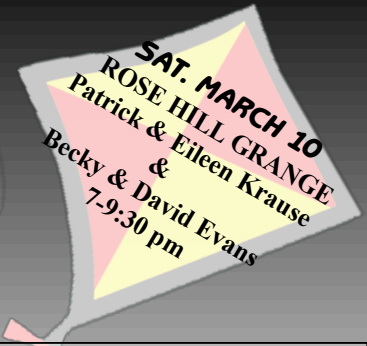

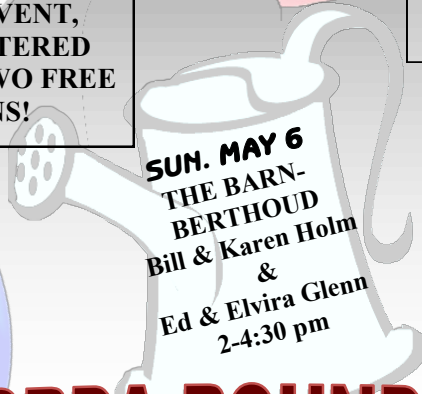

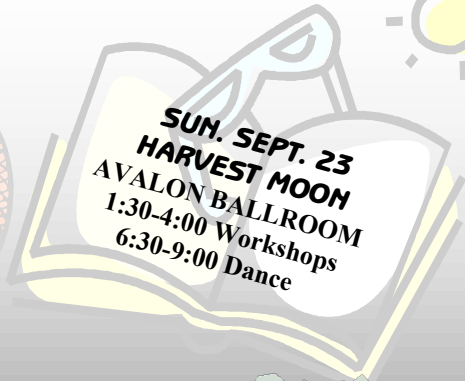

## Notes and dances from around Colorado (CRDA members input)

### Happy Feet Rounds (Grand Junction) Maxine & Dale Springer

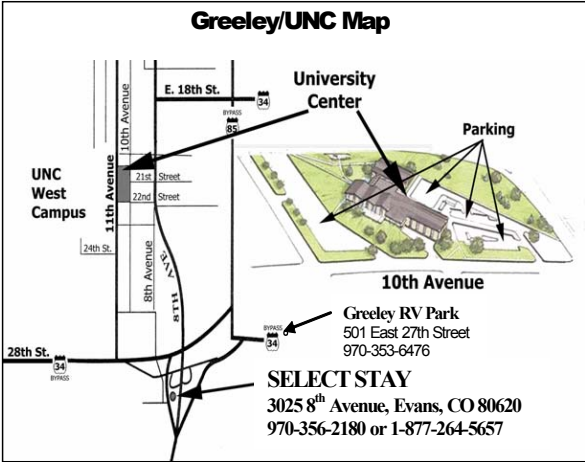
