#### Presidents Letter - Rob & Terri Sherwood

The next major CRDA event will be our annual Spring Dance, which focuses on new graduates from our cuer's classes. All CRDA members are encouraged to attend, and welcome the new dancers and encourage them to become CRDA members. Since some teachers start with easy ballroom and others with 2-Step, the program will include both ranges of rhythm types. A few higher level rounds will be included as a demonstration of what lies ahead, should the beginner dancers choose to progress up the phase levels. The dance will be held on Sunday, April 7th between 2:00 and 4:30 PM at the Avalon Ballroom in Boulder.

While it may not be obvious, round dancers who have come from a Square Dance background may have never seen anything but Phase II Rounds. I square danced for five years before going to Rocky Tops and seeing Alex-F being danced. That was a real eye-opener for me, providing a glimpse of the breadth of our hobby.

We are progressing with contract negotiations with Colorado State University – Pueblo as a replacement for UNC for next year. It will be a relief to get this nailed down.

Your previous issue of Round Notes was unusually long due to minutes being included from both the Annual General Meeting at the Gala and the January board meeting. Hopefully, the details allowed all members to have a feel for what your organization is doing to maintain our hobby in Colorado.

Jim and Sharon Peyrouse have accepted a position on our Cuer Selection Committee that looks for and contracts with out-of-state clinicians for our annual Gala. All CRDA members who attend other festivals should make a mental note of teachers who may be appropriate for consideration for our Gala. Please pass your thoughts on to any board member so this information may be forwarded to the committee. Unfortunately, the number of CRDA members who travel to other festivals has diminished in recent years. We need input about teachers who are "on the circuit" but may not immediately come to mind for consideration.

While I know we are all busy, we have two openings on the Hall of Fame committee. We need one single or couple for a one-year term, and another for a full three-year term. This position does not consume a lot of time, and in some years the HOF committee has conducted all its work via e-mail. How the HOF committee processes the nominations and scoring each year will be determined by them, whether done in person or via computer. Terri and I would prefer some volunteers step forward to fill these vacancies. It is always desirable to have a broad swath of our membership take turns participating in the nuts and bolts of our organization.

Eileen and Patrick Krause will be chairman of the Harvest Moon dance on September 22<sup>nd</sup> at the wonderful Avalon Ballroom in Boulder. The next board meeting will be April 13<sup>th</sup> at 2 PM at Rose Hill Grange. Any CRDA member may attend our board meetings.

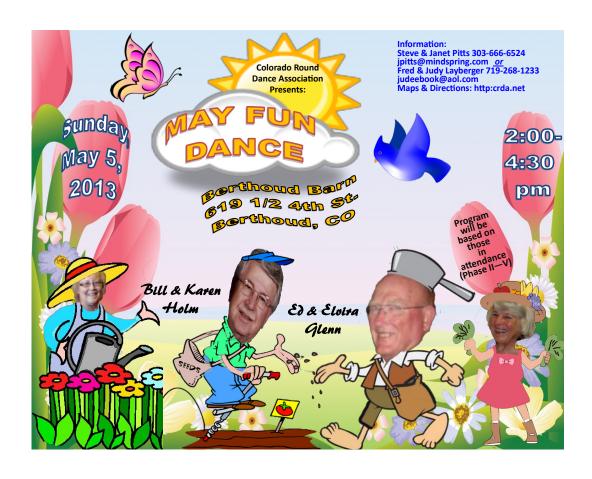

# DANCING MAKES YOU SMARTER

### **Top 4 Health Benefits of Dance**

Dancing is a great way for people of all ages to get and stay in shape. Besides being fun, dancing has many positive health benefits. Following are the top 4 health benefits of dance.

#### 1. Flexibility

Flexibility is an important part of being healthy. Dance requires a great amount of flexibility. Most dance classes begin with a warm-up including several stretching exercises. Dancers must strive to achieve full range of motion for all the major muscle groups. The greater the range of motion, the more muscles can flex and extend. Most forms of dance require dancers to perform moves that require bending and stretching, so dancers naturally become more flexible by simply dancing.

#### 2. Strength

Strength is defined as the ability of a muscle to exert a force against resistance. Dancing builds strength by forcing the muscles to resist against a dancer's own body weight. Many styles of dance, including jazz and ballet, require jumping and leaping high into the air. Jumping and leaping require tremendous strength of the major leg muscles. Ballroom dancing builds strength. Consider the muscle mass a male ballroom dancer develops by lifting his partner above his head!

#### 3. Endurance

Dance is physical exercise. Exercise increases endurance. Endurance is the ability of muscles to work hard for increasingly longer periods of time without fatigue. Regular dancing is great for improving endurance, especially vigorous dancing such as line and ballroom dancing. Elevating the heart rate can increase stamina. Just as in any form of exercise, regular dancing will build endurance.

#### 4. Sense of Well-Being

Dancing is a social activity. Studies have shown that strong social ties and socializing with friends contribute to high self-esteem and a positive outlook. Dancing provides many opportunities to meet other people. Joining a dance class can increase self-confidence and build social skills. Because physical activity reduces stress and tension, regular dancing gives an overall sense of well-being.
