For those who prefer to dance with cues, you will be pleased to know that some of the outstanding cuers in the round dance movement have volunteered to cue for your dancing pleasure. There will be a "Showcase" each night at 10:00 to demonstrate the teaches for the following day, and for the material to be covered in the clinics.

Each morning there will be two clinics for 1½ hours each conducted by a highly qualified Instructor giving the correct techniques for dancing several of the rhythms and figures which are popular in our round dance movement. If you want to further your round dance education, this will be your golden opportunity to see how the experts perform. During this same period, for those who prefer, there will be dancing in the other two ballrooms with all dances cued in one ballroom and request dances with no dances cued in the other ballroom.
