Topics for producing good choreography will include but not be limited to:

How to: choose, count & break down music into choreographic parts, use RAL phased figures & correct body mechanics, use highlights in the music to create memorable moments, match the choreography to a target audience, construct and proofread cue sheets.

What to bring to get the most out of the choreography school experience:

- Dance shoes – we will be dancing choreography as it is being produced
- Computer or other source for music (Access to YouTube would be very helpful)
- Earphones for working in the hall at the same time as others with different music (optional)
- A piece of music that you would be interested in using for choreography (optional)
- A piece of choreography of at least 8 measures, that you may have already written (optional)
- A list of questions that you might want answered during the school (optional)
- *No prior experience necessary. Do as much or as little preparation as is comfortable for you.

About the Washington/St. George Utah area: *Make a real vacation out of it!*

- Closest large airport is Las Vegas Nevada: 130 miles, 2 hours from the hall
- St. George regional airport is also available: 13 miles, 24 minutes from the hall

Close to many national and state parks, including:

- Zion National Park: 50 miles, 1 hour 25 min
- Cedar Breaks National Park: 72 miles, 1 hour 17 minutes
- North Rim of the Grand Canyon: 143 miles, 2 hours 45 min
- St. George's historic downtown and surrounding area have art museums, state parks, historic homes to visit- a vacation destination of its own.
